



Sample Bequest Language

The following language may help you and your attorney when drawing up a bequest that meets your needs.

General Bequest

- If you intend to make an outright bequest of cash, securities, or other property by designating a specific dollar amount, a particular asset, or a fixed percentage of your estate to the Harford County Education Foundation to be used for general purposes:

“I give and bequeath to the Harford County Education Foundation located in Bel Air, Maryland, the sum of \$_____.”

Residuary Bequest

- If you intend to leave the residue portion of your assets after other terms of the will have been satisfied:

“I give and bequeath to the Harford County Education Foundation located in Bel Air, Maryland, _____ (all or a percentage) of the rest, residual or remainder of my estate.”

Contingency Bequest

- If you wish to make a contingency gift, so that the Harford County Education Foundation will receive a portion of your estate if your named beneficiary does not survive you:

“If (insert name) is not living at the time of my death, I bequeath to the Harford County Education Foundation located in Bel Air, Maryland, the sum of \$_____ or _____ percent of the rest, residual or remainder of my estate.”

As with all planned gifts to the Harford County Education Foundation, donors who make a gift by bequest become members of the Legacy Society in recognition of their philanthropic generosity.
